COVID-19 Summary for Parents

-  School hours are 8:50am to 1:20pm for Juniors
08:50 - 1:30 pm for Seniors & 08:50 - 2:30pm for all others
-  Drop off at outside Wells Church, maintaining 2m distance.
-  Pick up from the side gate, maintaining 2m distance.
-  Pupils are encouraged to walk or cycle to school.
-  To pick up a child during school hours, please phone first.
-  There will be no access to the school building, bar exceptional circumstances.
-  All new staff will complete COVID induction training.
-  We will prioritise outdoor learning where possible. Pupils should bring a rain jacket/rainsuit, wellies and a change of clothes to leave in school.
-  All staff will wear a mask. Pupils are not required to wear a mask, but may do so if they would like to.
-  Pupils and staff will wash their hands regularly, using proper technique.
-  Everyone will use the hand sanitiser provided on entry and exit
-  The classrooms will be cleaned regularly. Toys will be disinfected as needed.
-  Pupils must be kept home with **high temperature, cough, breathing difficulties, loss of taste or smell, fatigue, aches and pains, runny nose, sore throat, headache, vomiting or diarrhoea.**
-  Pupils should follow the relevant procedures for restricting movement after travel as per [guidelines](#).
-  If showing symptoms, pupil will be isolated and parents called. Parents will then contact GP.
-  A class is one bubble. In the event of a case in the school, the Public Health team will contact close contacts.
-  Physical distancing is not required for junior age groups. Chairs will be spaced 1m apart, however pupils will mix during the day.
-  All pupils will have an individual box of stationery and supplies which will be kept in school.
-  Any shared resources will be wiped down at the end of the day.
